Under no circumstances will late modifications be accepted.

We recommend that you read this handbook in full before starting the process and complete the necessary formalities as soon as possible; the URJC processes applications strictly in the order in which they are received.

2.2. MODMAT application procedure

It is very important that you ensure you complete the **Learning Agreement modification** process at both **URJC** and **your home university**, if required to do so.

- 2.- To **continue with the MODMAT application** and **complete the tasks**, you must log in to the **electronic office**: <https://sede.urjc.es/en-GB/> and click on "Task" section.

TASK 1- COMPLETE AND CONFIRM YOUR DATA:

Once you have started your application on the **ELECTRONIC OFFICE** (<https://sede.urjc.es/en-GB/>), the system will display your personal details. You must ensure that they are correct, **particularly** your email address*, which the platform will use automatically **to contact you**.

You will receive **an email** stating **the reference number** for your open **MODMAT Learning agreement**: **2026/MODMAT-XXXXX**

You must always use this reference number exclusively for procedures relating to the **learning agreement modification**.

TASK 2- GENERATE MODIFICATION DOCUMENT:

Once your **MODMAT** record has been generated, an information screen will automatically appear showing **all the courses you are currently enrolled on**.

You must:

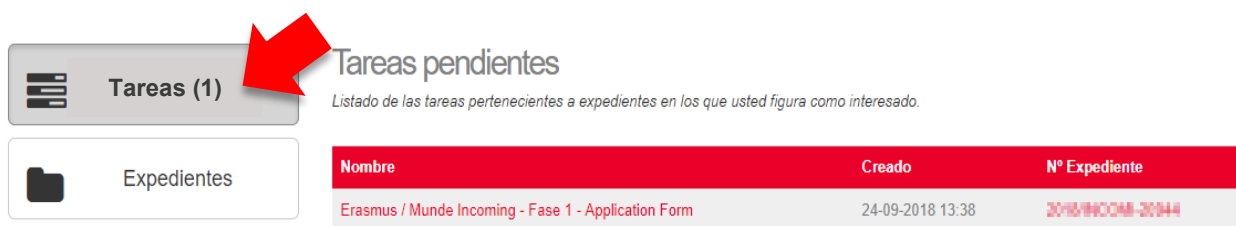
- Fill in the details on your **‘URJC learning agreement modification’** form
- Select the subjects** you are going to study at the URJC
You can **REMOVE** modules from your enrolment and/or **ADD** new modules.
See section **“2.3. Delete or add subjects – MODMAT”**
- Download the **URJC draft learning agreement modification**.
- Sign the **‘URJC Learning agreement modification document’** (to be signed by the **student** and their **home university**)
- Attach the **‘URJC Learning agreement modification document’** form, duly **completed and signed**.

**** Course selection:** Before making your selection, you **should check** the **timetables** (<https://servicios.urjc.es/horarios/?paso=1>) and **exams** (<https://servicios.urjc.es/examenes/>) and ensure that they are compatible with the subjects you wish to select.

Whether the document is **correct** or **incorrect**, you **will receive an email*** telling you what you need to do to continue and complete your application

***All emails will be sent to the email address you provided when you started your application on the Online Portal; if you did not provide one, the emails will be sent to your URJC email address.**

2.3. Add and/or delete subjects – MODMAT

**Learning agreement modification (MODMAT)**

You can delete some or all of the subjects you are enrolled in by selecting '**Delete module**' and then '**Continue**'.

In the **drop-down menu**, you will see the subjects you are enrolled in (URJC's 'Learning Agreement Before' template); select the one you wish to delete and click '**Continue**'.

The subjects you have selected for deletion will appear in the draft as **(DELETED)**.

+ Add subjects:

Select '**Add subject**' and '**Continue**'.

In the **drop-down menu**, you will see the degree programmes/areas of study for the Faculty/School and Campus for which you have been nominated.

Select the **degree programme** and **find the course** within it that you wish to add.

The subjects you have selected to add will appear in the draft as **(ADDED)**.

The drop-down menu will only show subjects with places available.

Once you have finished adding and/or removing subjects, the **URJC Learning Agreement Modification document** (Learning Agreement During) **will only show the subjects that you have removed and/or added:**

- You will be **withdrawn** from any subjects marked as **(DELETED)** – those that you have deleted.
- Of those marked **(ADDED)** – the ones you have added – **you will be enrolled on them.**

The document will NOT show the subjects from your **original Learning Agreement** (Learning Agreement Before) that you have not modified; you will remain enrolled on those subjects.

2.4. How to correctly select the subjects.



Avoiding clashes between timetables and exams – MANDATORY

Students are required to **check the timetables and examination schedules on the URJC's official website and to ensure that these are compatible** with the subjects they wish to enrol in, **before selecting their subjects.**

Check the **timetables and exams** in the section **“Links that MUST be consulted before selecting subjects”**



Subject selection

You must choose at least 50 per cent of your subjects from your chosen degree programme.

The **remaining subjects** must be from degree programmes in:

Same **field of study**
Same **language of the exchange**
Same **FACULTY**
Same **CAMPUS**
Same **semester/mobility period**



It will NOT be possible to select:
(except for specific agreements)

- Modern language
- Reconocimiento Académico de Créditos (RAC)
Academic recognition of credits
- Trabajo Fin de Grado (TFG) (*Final-year dissertation*)
- Prácticum

Check the **academic offer** at the end of the document.



Mandatory credits per semester:

18 ECTS minimum or 3 subjects

Also check the minimum requirements set by your home university.



Term in which courses are taught:

- **1Q** → First semester
- **2Q** → Second semester
- **A** → Annual (*just anual students*)

Health Sciences Faculty students

- If you wish to make **amendments to your learning agreement**, you must follow the same procedure as set out in this manual.
- **They are NOT allowed to choose subjects from other Bachelors.**



Master students with specific agreement

- If you wish to make **amendments to your learning agreement**, you must follow the same procedure as set out in this manual.
- **They are NOT allowed to choose subjects from other Bachelors or Masters.**



Arts and Dance Students

- If you wish to make **amendments to your learning agreement**, you must follow the same procedure as set out in this manual.
- **They are NOT allowed to choose subjects from other Bachelors.**

In the **course catalogue**, you will find the **course codes** for each course, the **course title**, the **number of ECTS credits**, the **semester** in which it is taught and the **course type**, organized by year of study for each degree program.

You should look up each degree using the **degree codes** listed in the **Academic Program** (at the end of this document).

*Ex: To search for the **BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT (ENGLISH)**, enter the code **2048***

At this link, in addition to the **curriculum for each degree**, you will find the approved **teaching guides** for each subject.

You should read the information carefully to familiarize yourself with the course content, the level of prior knowledge required, any prerequisites from previous years, or any other important details that may affect your future performance. You should also check this with the coordinator at your home university.

- No document will be signed or stamped by hand.
- Original paper documents sent by post or digital documents sent by email will not be accepted.
- All documents related to your mobility are available at the **URJC's ELECTRONIC OFFICE** (<https://sede.urjc.es/en-GB/>) in your "**Carpeta Ciudadana**" (Citizen folder/User Panel) digitally signed*

Students can access their documents via either the **“Expedientes”** (Dossiers) tab (**2026/INCOMI-xxxx**) or the **“Documentos”** (Documents) tab; to view a **list of all documents**, they must click **“Buscar”** (Search) button.

Students must download their **digitally signed*** documents by clicking on **“Copia auténtica”** (Authentic copy) and **submit it to their home University**.

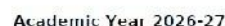

- All 1st semester, 2nd semester and full-year students must be nominated during the regular nomination period (April–May)
- **HEALTH SCIENCES ANNUAL** students must bear in mind that their mobility must be during the **SPANISH ACADEMIC YEAR** (September–May)
- **B2 Spanish certificate** is mandatory for all Health Sciences students.
- They're not allowed to take subjects from other bachelor degrees.
