## 3.2. Application procedure

### TASK 1- UPLOAD FIRST DOCUMENTS:

Once you have started your application at the **ELECTRONIC OFFICE** (<https://sede.urjc.es/inicio>), the system will ask you to **upload your first REQUIRED documents**:


- **Special needs report** (if applicable)
- **Passport or ID** (valid until the end of the mobility period)
- **Language certificate**. Make sure you upload the **correct language certificate\***

#### TASK 2- LEARNING AGREEMENT:

Once the **first set of documents** has been accepted, a **new task** will appear, asking you to complete your **Learning Agreement**:

- Complete the information on your **Learning agreement**
- Select the **subjects\*\*** you are going to study at URJC
- Download the **URJC Learning agreement draft**.
- Sign the **Learning agreement** (student's signature and home university signature)
- Upload the **complete and correctly signed Learning agreement**.

**\*\* Selection of subjects:** Before making their choice, students **should check the timetables** (<https://servicios.urjc.es/horarios/?paso=1>) and **exams** (<https://servicios.urjc.es/examenes/>) and make sure they are compatible with the modules they intend to choose.

#### ACCEPTANCE LETTER:

Once the **Learning Agreement** has been reviewed, approved and signed by URJC, your **Letter of Acceptance** will be issued, and the process will be considered complete.

Any student who **does NOT receive the Letter of Acceptance** by the specified deadline, **will NOT be enrolled and will therefore NOT be officially accepted by the URJC.**

### 3.3. How to correctly select your subjects



#### Avoiding clashes between timetables and exams – MANDATORY

Students are required **to check the timetables and exam schedules on the URJC's official website** and **ensure that these are compatible with the modules** they wish to enroll in **before selecting their modules**.

Check the **timetables and exams** in the section "**Links you MUST consult before selecting your modules**".



#### Subjects selection

You must choose **at least 50%** of the modules for **your chosen degree programme**.

The **remaining modules** must be from the following degree programs:

Same **Study area**  
Same **language of mobility**  
Same **FACULTY**  
Same **CAMPUS**  
Same **semester/mobility period**



**It will NOT be possible to select:**  
*(except for specific agreements)*

- Idioma Moderno (*Modern Language*)
- Reconocimiento Académico de Créditos (RAC) *Academic Recognition of credits*
- Trabajo Fin de Grado (TFG) (*Final-year dissertation*)
- Prácticum

**18 ECTS minimum** or **3 subjects**

#### Learning agreement modification (MODMAT)

**Sort of application:** online at Electronic Office (MODMAT)

**Reasons and acceptance:** Such requests will only be accepted in the event of **timetable clashes**, capacity issues with the previously selected module, and, in **very exceptional cases, for other reasons**, provided that a request is made and prior justification is provided by the home university.

**Instructions and deadlines will be sent to students by email** in the days following the Welcome day. This is expected to take place after the start of the semester.

## 3.5. Special cases



### Health Sciences Faculty students

- All **1<sup>st</sup> semester, 2<sup>nd</sup> semester and full-year students** must be nominated during the **regular nomination period** (April–May).
- Students on an **annual** exchange program must undertake it during the URJC **academic year** (September–May).
- **B2 Spanish certificate mandatory.**
- **They are NOT permitted to choose modules from other degrees.**

You will be **contacted by email** once your nomination has been accepted and during the application process **to provide you with specific guidance on course selection**, and you will be informed of your **designated URJC coordinator**.



### Master students with specific agreement

Only students who have been nominated for a **MASTER'S PROGRAMME (under a specific agreement)** may **choose MASTER'S COURSES**, and **only from the MASTER'S PROGRAMME to which they have been nominated**.

You will be **contacted by email** once your nomination has been accepted and during the application process **to provide you with specific guidance on course selection**, and you will be informed of your **designated URJC coordinator**.



### Arts and Dance Students

- They must be **annual** students (URJC academic year)
- There are certain admission requirements.
- **They are NOT allowed to choose modules from other years.**

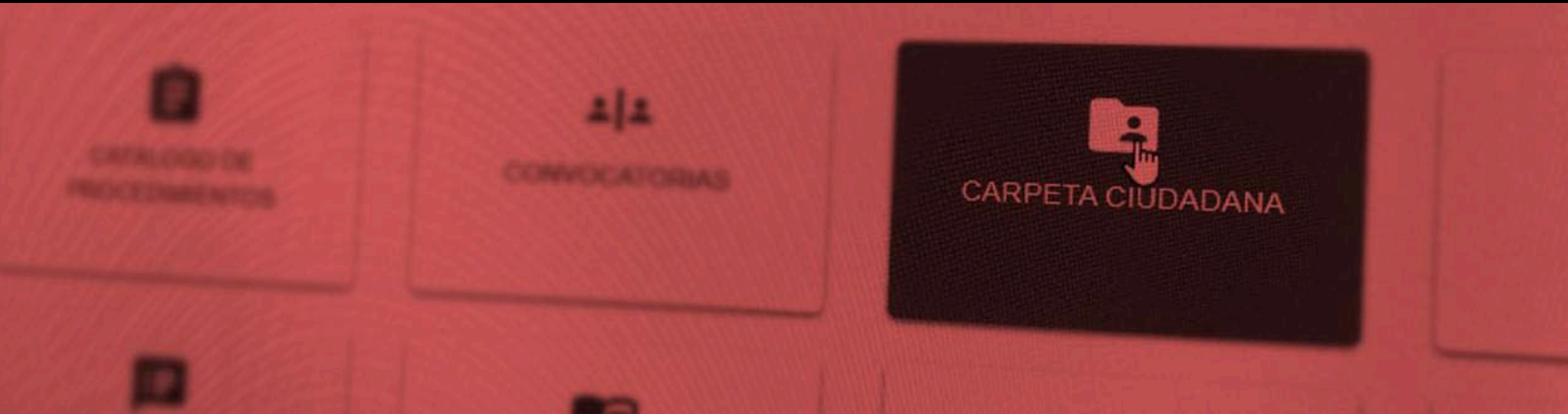


