ACADEMIC CALENDAR 2025-26

Ist Semester (Fall-winter):

Welcome Day: predictably will take place during the 9th September 2025

Semester duration: from I Ith September 2025 to 22nd January 2026

Class period: from IIth September to I9th December 2025

Exams period: from 8th to 22nd January 2026

2nd Semester (Spring-summer):

Welcome Day: predictably will take place during the 21st - 22nd January 2026

Semester duration: from 23rd January to 26th May 2026

Class period: from 23rd January to 8th May 2026 Exams period: from 11th to 26th May 2026

Extraordinary Exams period:

Only for students who did not pass any subject during ordinary exams periods. The extraordinary exams period will be from 10th June to 4th July 2026.

These are Official Dates and CANNOT be changed.


4. Login with SSO URJC CREDENCIALES:



GENERATING THE 2ND SEMESTER MOBILITY EXTENSION LEARNING AGREEMENT

Once your Extension of Mobility Application has been accepted, you must do your 2nd Semester Extension of Mobility Learning Agreement.

Go to the platform and enter your file (2025/AMPLIA-xxx)

Go to "Tasks" and complete the form you must FILL IN and VERIFY ALL DATA*.

It is very important that you make sure that you have entered them correctly because these data

CANNOT BE CHANGED AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN ENTERED.

Fill in the contact data of your home university, it will be used by URJC.

Verify and complete all the data of your mobility at URJC.

Once you have filled in your personal details and those of both universities, an information screen will be automatically displayed. It will show:

1.- At the **top box**, the list of your **I**st **semester subjects**. This information can't be modified.

Once filled your 2nd Semester Learning Agreement you must:

- **Download** and **save the document**. (URJC's Learning Agreement Draft Model)
- Complete the corresponding table with the **subjects approved at your Home University** (Table B)



- Sign the document: Student's and home university's signatures are mandatory.
- Upload the document to the platform.

In case of having your own model of Learning Agreement, our recommendation is that the student would upload his/her model, signed by the student and his/her home university, but IT IS COMPULSORY TO GENERATE CORRECTLY THE DRAFT OF THE URJC MODEL. The subjects* (TABLE A) and the information in both models MUST BE THE SAME. *(Component code, Component title at the Receiving Institution, Semester Number of ECTS credits, etc).

DO NOT MODIFY the list of subjects on TABLE A of the signed document, it must be exactly the same as TABLE A of the URJC draft. If you need to re-select the subjects, upload a pdf document in which you indicate that you need to do it. For example: I made a mistake selecting the subjects. Please let me select them again.

Once the document has been uploaded, correctly completed and signed, the URJC will check it and if it is correct, will approve it and sign it digitally; only from this moment on, your 2nd Semester Learning Agreement will be approved.

You will receive an email when the enrolment has been completed.

Remember that you will not see the changes in your **Virtual Classroom** and **Schedule** in **48** hours.

Please note that **blended learning subjects (subjects labelled as "semipresenciales")** do not have an assigned schedule, as there are no compulsory presential classes. In this case you must check your **Virtual Classroom** and **follow the instructions of each teacher** because they may be different for each subject.

HOW TO SELECT CORRECTLY YOUR LEARNING AGREEMENT SUBJECTS

AT LEAST 50% OF THE SUBJECTS MUST BE OF THE DEGREE YOU HAVE BEEN NOMINATED TO.

If you need to mix areas of study, you must **ALWAYS** choose **50%** of the subjects of the degree you have been nominated to and the rest among the degrees of the same field of study, mobility language/es, same mobility period (2Q), same FACULTY, and same CAMPUS.

For example: if you have been nominated to study Business Administration you can select Marketing Degree subjects; or if you have been nominated for Computer Engineering you can select subjects from the Software Engineering Degree.

Only students who have been nominated to **MASTER STUDIES** (under specific agreement) can choose **MASTER SUBJECTS**, and only from the **MASTER they have been nominated** to.

Arts and Dance students are NOT allowed to choose subjects from other degrees.



If you are going to study a Degree from the **Faculty of Health Sciences**, keep in mind that: Health Sciences students **cannot mix subjects from other degrees**.

Most of the subjects are ANNUAL, so if you are coming to study during one semester you MUST select the semestral ones 1Q or 2Q, depending on the semester that you are nominated to, Practicum included.

The number of credits for **ONE SEMESTER** at URJC **CAN'T BE LESS than 18 ECTS or 3 subjects (minimum).** Check the minimum ECTS required per semester at your home university.

The Spanish academic calendar is divided into 2 periods, which correspond approximately to the 1st semester (from September to January) and the 2nd semester (from January to May).

You can choose subjects from all the years that make up the degree you have been nominated to BUT only those taught in the 2nd semester.

So, you can see these references: IQ = Ist semester, 2Q = 2nd semester. A = annual

You can find this information in the **Teaching Itinerary** of each Degree, (the number in the left column is the semester and at the top of the list of subjects you'll will find the course/year in which the subject is taught within the degree). (see screenshot below)

PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY to learn deeply about the subjects' contents, level of knowledge required or any other important specific information, which may affect to your future performance. And double check it with your home university coordinator.

We recommend that you download, save, and print the **Teaching Guides** of the subjects that you are going to take during your mobility at the URJC.

Teaching Guides are **digitally signed**, so if your home university asks you to hand it signed you can download it and forward it to your home university.

HOW TO CHECK THE SCHEDULE

Please note that **blended learning subjects (subjects labelled as "semipresenciales")** do not have an assigned schedule, as there are no compulsory presential classes. In this case, once you get enrolled, you will have to check your **Virtual Classroom** and **follow the instructions of each teacher** because they may be different for each subject.

Due to external reasons to this service regarding quota availability, URJC cannot guarantee the schedule of the selected subjects. (Students can be assigned to morning or afternoon timetables).

PERSONAL SCHEDULE (only after subjects' enrolment):

To check your **personal schedule**, you must enter the link (https://gestion2.urjc.es/horarios/?paso=1), click on 'students' and login with your URJC username and password. Remember that you will only be able to see it once you are enrolled.

GENERAL SCHEDULES:

To check **subjects' general schedules** you must search in the **List of Subjects** (https://gestion4.urjc.es/libroasignaturas/) the **Degree** to which it belongs, the **Course**, and the **Semester** and then with these data search in **schedule link**.

For instance:

To check **2048**010- FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING II schedule:

1.- Search the degree by **AREA OF STUDY CODE**: 2048 is the code for **GRADO EN ADMINISTRACION Y DIRECCION DE EMPRESAS (INGLES) (VICALVARO) – (Administration and Business Management in English at Vicálvaro Campus)**





2.- Find the subject in the list: 2048010- FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING II is a SEGUNDO CURSO (Second year) and 2nd semester (2Q) subject.



3.- Then go to HORARIOS (SCHEDULES): https://gestion2.urjc.es/horarios/?paso=1



4.- Select **Consulta Grado, complete the form** and click on "**Buscar**" (search):

You must roll-over on the subject to see the Teacher (Professor) and the Classroom (Aula) where the subject is taught.

To **AVOID EXAMS OVERLAPS**, you must check the date and time of ordinary and extraordinary exams here: https://gestion2.urjc.es/examenes/

Bear in mind that **learning agreement modifications** "LEARNING AGREEMENT DURING" will be **only accepted** only due to **overlapping schedules**, **lack of quota** issues of subjects that were previously selected, and exceptionally - upon request by home university- other justified reasons will be considered. Learning agreement modification procedure instructions, will be sent via email to students once the 2Q has started.





How do I access the SSO - CREDENCIALES*?

The SSO is not a direct access platform. It is only requested when it is necessary to identify yourself after trying to access the URJC corporate applications and/or services integrated within the SSO single sign-on system.

How do I identify myself in the URJC SSO - CREDENCIALES*?


When an application requests identification via SSO the following screen will appear:

LOGGING IN WITH "CREDENCIALES*": It allows you to identify yourself by **logging in using your URJC email** (for example: your.user.2025@alumnos.uric.es) and **password.**If necessary, **a second authentication factor** (Microsoft Authenticator) will also be required to verify identification.





Microsoft Authenticator Settings:

As a user you must configure the **double factor**:

- Authenticator App in your smartphone.

Login issues:

If you try to access any URJC app with a URJC corporate account and you are undergoing login issues, it may be due to:

You are entering your username incorrectly:

Depending on the service you want to access, it may be necessary to enter the user using your **URJC full email address** (your.user.2025@alumnos.urjc.es) or not (your.user.2025). You must check if this is the reason why you cannot access normally. Remember that the **password is always the same**.

You may have forgotten your password:

You can reset your password through this link. https://cambioclave.urjc.es/ You will receive an email to your personal email account or an SMS to your contact mobile phone with instructions on how to reset your password.

• You are trying to log in via Simplified Sign-On (SSO) – "CREDENCIALES*" while you are already logged in with a different account.

Please note that if you use **another Office365 account** different to your personal URJC corporate account, **access will fail**.

To avoid this, use different web browsers for each account.



Additionally, you can **log in with a different browser**, **private window** or **log out of the SSO** clicking on "Cerrar sesión" (Log out) button at https://identifica.urjc.es and then close the browser.
