- Your spouse or children (dependents) can accompany you to the U.S on J2 visa, which enables them to work or study in the USA.

- You'll become a global teacher! It's a unique opportunity to learn different methods of teaching while also bringing an important international perspective to U.S. classrooms and students.

Who is eligible?

You are supposed to satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria given below to participate in Teach USA program.

- Education qualification equivalent to a USA bachelor's degree
- Two years full-time teaching experience after date of Bachelor's Degree
- Degree must be from an accredited university
- Advanced proficiency in oral and written English
- Credential evaluation from an approved USA agency



Application

We share your information with U.S. school districts that are interested in hosting international teachers. We notify you if a school is interested in hiring you or speaking with you by phone or Skype about a teaching position.

Evaluation

We carefully review every qualified application. If your application is accepted, you will be invited to participate in a telephone or Skype interview to discuss your application and evaluate your compatibility with our programs.

Placement

Complete the online application form to provide details about your teaching experience, educational background, country of residence, and any accompanying family members.

Arrival

We will meet you in the USA upon your arrival and help you apply for social security number, arrange a temporary housing and meet your school manager.

Pre-departure

Once you get your j1 visa, we will send you Teach USA participant guide explaining all the details you should know and do before and after arrival. We will also help you with travel arrangements, airport transportation.

Visa

After you accept a job offer, we will send you the documents you need to apply for a J-1 visa.
